ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Water District 19 (District) at the District's office (17630 100th Avenue SW, Vashon, WA 98070) or via mail (PO Box T, Vashon, WA 98070) until 1:00 pm on February 17, 2012 for construction of the Ridge Road Water Main Replacement, Phase II. Bids will then be opened, read, and tabulated publicly. Proposals received after the time fixed for opening will not be considered.

Work to be performed includes the installation of approximately 660 feet of 8-inch diameter AWWA C900 PVC pipe, and related valves, fittings, couplings and miscellaneous appurtenances and other work.

Contract documents may be obtained from the District at 17630 100th Avenue SW, Vashon, WA 98070, (206) 463-9007, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$30 for each set. Checks must be made payable to the Water District 19. An informational copy of the contract documents is on file for inspection at the District office.

Bid packages will be mailed through USPS standard mail upon request. Additional charges may apply for express mailing. Each bid proposal shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, postal money order, or surety bond in an amount equal to at least five (5) percent of the amount of such bid proposal. Checks shall be made payable to the Water District 19. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance and payment bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the District.

The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities in the bid or in the bidding. The District hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into, pursuant to this advertisement, minority and women's business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to the invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

No bidder may withdraw his proposal after the hours set for the opening thereof, or before award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding 60 calendar days.

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
