2. BOARD DISCUSSION/ACTION

- Street Lighting Policy Master Resolution reviewed existing policy to consider revisions. **The Board** is in agreement to revise the Street Lighting Policy within the Master Resolution.
- Proposed quiet title action for Beall Creek watershed parcel 322303UNKN (approx. 4.5 ac.)
 Court action will cost about \$2000.00. Commissioner Bard made a Motion authorizing General Manager Lakin the authority to proceed with a quiet title action on parcel 322303UNKN; Commissioner Powell seconded the Motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- WA GA Enterprise Services purchasing services membership. The Board approved joining
