# Tuesday, August 14, 2012

### REGULAR MEETING 4:30 PM

### Meeting came to order at 4:30 PM

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Water District 19 was held at the District Office. Those in attendance were President **Steve Haworth**, Commissioners **Richard Bard** and **Bob Powell**, General Manager **Jeff Lakin**, Operations Lead **Armin Wahanik** and Office Administrator **Melody Snyder**.

#### 1. VISITOR BUSINESS

• There was no visitor business.

#### 2. BOARD DISCUSSION/ACTION

- Leak adjustment policy review/ revisit a proposal to revise the policy to be based on the wholesale cost of the water was presented to the **Board**. The **Board** came to consensus to revise the policy as presented and incorporate into the Master Resolution draft.
- Office roof changes parapet removal Construction is going as planned, roof panels had to be special ordered. Work should be completed by the end of the month.
- Approval of minutes Tuesday, July 10, 2012 Commissioner Powell made a Motion to approve the minutes as submitted; Commissioner Bard seconded the Motion. Motion approved unanimously.
- School District Joint Planning Process No word yet from Eric Gill at the School District –
   Commissioner Haworth will attempt to make contact to expedite moving forward on the project.

#### 3. OPERATIONS REPORT

- Beall Treatment Plant operations so far biggest peak day has been 574,000 gallons in early August.
- Discussed elevated March THM's.
- Beall well new flow controls in service.

#### 4. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

- FCS Group proposed contract for Local Facilities Charge policy review. The **Board** requested taking a second look at the desired deliverables to reduce cost.
- Automated meter reading system work progressing. Still working out some software glitches, should be ready to implement new AMR devices by end of month.
- Quiet title action for Beall Creek watershed parcel 322303UNKN still in progress. General Manager Lakin reported that the District had not purchased the parcel as reported in the July 10, 2012 minutes; the seller of the property never signed the purchasing agreement. A condemnation proceeding was initiated. Next steps are to pursue locating and acquiring the court records.
- Northshore Utility District they've created a wage and benefit database all web based. WASWD will have a link on their site.
- Master Resolution anticipate completion in fall. The **Board** requested an executive summary of data revisions in the capacity report to be presented in conjunction with the draft 2013 budget in October.
