Meeting came to order at 4:30 PM

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Water District 19 was held at the District Office. 1. VISITOR BUSINESS

2. BOARD DISCUSSION/ACTION

- Master Resolution Counsel Review Commissioner Haworth called for a special meeting to focus on Counsel comments and suggested revisions. The meeting will be on Thursday, October 18th, 2012 at 10:00 am. Board counsel will attend the meeting by telephone.
- Dental Plan alternate plan consideration General Manager Lakin provided three years worth of District dental claims history. A self-managed plan will potentially be less expensive and provide more coverage per employee. The Board made no decisions at this time.
- 2013 Budget First draft overview **Commissioner Haworth** called for a special meeting for Tuesday, October 16th, 2012 at 10:00 am to allow for more time for the Board to review the 2013 budget. Staffing changes, rate tier/base changes and capital budget were discussed.
- Approval of minutes September 11, 2012 **Commissioner Powell** made a Motion to approve the minutes as written; **Commissioner Haworth** seconded the Motion. Motion approved unanimously.

3. OPERATIONS REPORT

 Beall Well operations – Operations Lead Wahanik reported that Beall Well had been off for 3 months. Beall well information will be on the monthly report.
 Morgan Hill well taken off line to complete a recovery test. Peak day for 2012 below 700,000 gallons.

4. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

- School Well Commissioner Haworth and General Manager Lakin met with School
 District Superintendent Michael Soltman and Eric Gill to discuss the proposed joint well
 project. Tom Dargel, School District Business Manager has made a request for additional
 data regarding potential savings on water bills. Expect a response by next school board
 meeting.
- Automated meter reading system Still encountering a few software glitches but staff was able to download meter reads into the billing software.
- Bid opening PRVs The district received two bids. Lowest bid was H.D. Supply Waterworks at \$102, 697.00. **General Manager Lakin** to proceed with bid award and ordering process.

• Beall Creek watershed parcel 322303UNKN update – **General Manager Lakin** found the actual sale documents confirming the District ownership of the property. Counsel will take the lead on contacting King County for proper recording.
