Board President **Bob Powell** called the Regular Meeting of The Water District 19 Board of Commissioners to order at 6:30 PM. Commissioners **Seth Zuckerman** and **Michael Weller** and General Manager **Jim McRae** were also present.

• BOARD – ACTION REQUIRED

- Resolution 1173 to increase the transfer of funds from the Cash/Management Fund to the Capital
 Improvement Fund from \$10,000 per month to \$20,000 per month was presented to the Board. Motion was
 made by Commissioner Zuckerman, seconded by Commissioner Weller and approved by all
 Commissioners.
- General Manager McRae updated the Board on the continuing discussions with the Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network (PSERN) who intends to construct a radio tower adjacent to the District's main well site. PSERN is requesting the District to grant an easement to the landowner, who will be renting the site to King County, an easement for access to the site. Five conditions need to be met in order for the District to grant the easement; 1. A survey drawing, 2. A legal description, 3. The easement needs to fall exactly on the existing road that has been used for some time, 4. Limit access to everyone except PSERN and their agents, and 5. A complete management agreement that spells out maintenance & improvements required that will beborne by each party to the agreement.
- **General Manager McRae** informed the board that the insurance premiums for next year will be increased by 5.64% to \$32,290 per year.
- General Manager McRae presented the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) to the board for discussion and approval. The order and cost of the plan was generally accepted and the final changes will be presented at the November 12th regular board meeting. With the CIP costs finalized, the board will also be presented the complete financial models at that meeting.
