SW 216TH STREET WATER MAIN ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE \$2,400,000 TO \$2,700,000

Sealed Proposals will be received by the undersigned at the Water District 19 office, 17630 100th Avenue SW, Vashon, Washington 98070, up to 2:00 p.m.; local time on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, for furnishing the necessary labor, materials, equipment, tools, and guarantees thereof to construct SW 216th Street Water Main.

The project includes the installation of new 12-inch diameter water main on Vashon Highway and new 8-inch water main on SW 216th Street and Monument Road in Vashon. The project includes two schedules of work. Schedule A includes work on Vashon Highway and SW 216th Street. Schedule B includes work on Monument Road. The work also includes the installation of a new pressure reducing valve station on Monument Road.

The Work shall be physically complete within 80 working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed. All bidding and construction is to be performed in compliance with the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans for this project and any addenda issued thereto that are on file at the office of the District Manager, District Office, Vashon, Washington.

The Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly after the time and date stated above. Proposals are to be submitted only on the form provided with the Bid Documents. All Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check, postal money order, cashiers check, or Proposal bond payable to the "Water District 19" and in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total Proposal amount.
